This Deed made this seventeenth day of December 1850 between Wm. M. Beaton and his late wife, of the first part and George W. Cole of the second part, Witnesseth that in consideration of fifty dollars the said Wm. M. Beaton and his late wife do grant unto the said George W. Cole with general warranty a certain lot situated near Boykins Depot containing one half acre in the same manner as on the west side of the road leading from Boykins Depot to the plantation of Wm. M. Beaton, the boundaries of said lot, being as follows to wit: commencing on public road and running South along said road to a stake near a large ditch which crosses the said public road, the distance from the commencement to the said stake being thirty four yards, thence twenty yards in a westerly course to another stake, thence thirty five yards north to a lot now occupied by S. H. Hill, thence along the line of said lot twenty yards to the public road, the said lot being situated directly opposite the land owned by G. L. Barden, on my part to him in the year 1848, for the said Wm. M. Beaton, for himself and wife do covenant that he has the right to convey the said land to the grantee, that he has no claim or acts to encumber the said lands, that the grantee shall quiet up the person of the said land free from all encumbrances and that he, the said Wm. M. Beaton party of the first part, will execute such further assurance of the said land as may be required, Witness the following signatures and seals
