R. Branch of Branches of the Depot during the year 1881. There is at this writing about one hundred cords of said wood cut and the remaining four hundred cords & do covenant with the said Beaton cut by the first day of April 1881 Beaton delivers all of said wood as so seen in the said year an encumbrance with permit that I will have said wood cut and delivered to said Beaton in a convenient manner and that the title to it is good and dispatch and I will not by any act of my own or through any legal representation encumber said wood that the said Beaton to have and to hold the said wood to him now for ever.
