This Deed made this 15th day of June 1800 between Epheus Beal and Nancy his wife of the County of Solis of the State of Virginia grantors of the first part and William Pittman of the County of Southampton State of Virginia grantee of the second part with full that in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to them hereof paid the said Epheus Beal and Nancy his wife do hereby acknowledge that the said Epheus Beal and Nancy his wife do grant bargain sell and convey with full power of warranty unto the said William Pittman the following real property lying and situated in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows commencing at the Southwestern intersection of Mechanic's street and Adams street extending through the lot of the said Epheus Beal thence along said Adams street in easterly direction one hundred and five (105) feet on the west by Mechanic's street 47 feet 7 inches on the south by parallel with the said Adams street and thence with said 27 feet one inch to said Adams street the last corner bounding being parallel with Mechanic's street and said lot containing a little less than 1/2 acre with the said grantors covenants to make any further assurances necessary to convey unto said grantee a perfect and undisturbed title to said lot and parcels of land to him and his heirs forever.
