

This Deed of Bargain and Sale made the 27th day of December 1856 between William H. Pittman and his wife of the County of Southampton, the first party, and James Davis of the County of Virginia, State of Virginia, grantee of the second party, both of whom are acknowledged by their signatures, witnesseth that the said parties, hereby acknowledge, that the said William H. Pittman and his wife do have a tract of land, containing one hundred and four acres, more or less, situated in the town of Franklin, County of Southampton, and bounded as follows, commencing at the northeast intersection of Mechanic Street, the same extending through that street to a point more or less east of the said street, thence along said street in an easterly direction one hundred and four (104) feet, northward by mechanic street 27 feet 4 inches south by parallel with said street 104 feet, thence on the east 14 feet more or less due east, the last named boundary being parallel with mechanic street, said lot containing a little less than one-half acre of land, now owned by the said W. H. Pittman, by deed of Bargain and Sale from John Bush and wife, bearing date the 1st day of January, A.D. 1856, the said William H. Pittman, do covenant that they have the right to make this conveyance, that they have done no act to encumber said property, and that they will make every further arrangement necessary to give the said grantee an undisturbed title to said lot together with all rights thereto belonging.
