

This third made the third day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty five
 between Hamilton Diggs and Mason and his wife of the County of Southampton
 of the first part and Sam Murray of the County of Southampton party of the second part,
 witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars the sum
 of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Hamilton Diggs and Mason and his wife
 Sam Murray, with general warranty, all right title and interest in a certain tract
 of land situated in Southampton Diggs by K.M. Urquhart afterwards divided by said Southampton Diggs
 to Hamilton Diggs bounded on the East by the Blackwater River & the lands of K.M. Urquhart
 and south & west by the lands of said Urquhart. The said Hamilton Diggs & Mason and his
 wife doth covenant that they have the right to convey the said land to the grantee, that they have done
 no act to interfere with the said land, that the grantee shall have quiet possession of the said land free
 from all encumbrances, and that they the said parties of the first part will execute such further
 warrant of the said land as may be requisite. Witness the following signatures and seals.
