

This Deed made this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October in the year 1830 between W. P. Debrell grantor of the first part and Jas D. Darden grantee of the second, John G. Vick and Escline his wife did on the fifteenth day of April 1830 by a certain deed of trust grant unto W. P. Debrell a certain tract of land known as the James Worrell place situated containing three hundred and two acres for the purpose of securing a certain debt there is named, and is now the said John

V. all the said land at public auction to the highest bidder for cash, and Jas D. Darden became the purchaser thereof for the sum of nine hundred and Eighty Dollars and which was the said Jas D. Darden has paid the said sum of Nine hundred and Eighty Dollars to the said W. P. Debrell northerly for the said debt. It is further that the said W. P. Debrell doth grant unto Jas D. Darden a certain tract of land in Southampton County known as the James Worrell place containing the same yards said tract of land for the sum of G. Vick containing by estimate three hundred hundred another acre the said land being sold by the tract and not acres, and bounded by the lands of Benj Peppard Mills Worrell deceased Joe P. Peppard Holland and John D. Martin, and the said W. P. Debrell doth hereby covenant and agree with the said Jas D. Darden to warrant and defend unto him such title as is vested in him by the deed of the 15<sup>th</sup> of April 1830 and none other, as witness the following signature and seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1830.

This Deed of trust made the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1831 between Elias P. Vick & Margaret J. Vick his wife of the first part, Walter Bown trustee of the second part & Mrs. Caroline A. Peppard of the third part. Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of Six dollars thousand parties of the first part defendant and convey with general warranty to the said Walter Bown trustee of the first party defendant and convey with general warranty to the said Walter Bown trustee of the second party plaintiff the following tract of land situated in Southampton County, Virginia known as the Rose Place containing six hundred & thirty acres more or less bounded by the lands of John L. Byrd, George E. Britton, Mr. Harris, Mr. A. Peppard, Dr. James F. Francis. In trust however the payment of the following note, viz one note for eight hundred and thirty six dollars of even date with this deed with interest from date. And it is agreed by the parties hereto that the parties of the first part will insue his aforesaid buildings on said tract of land to the amount of five hundred dollars annually for the benefit of the party of the third part. And it is further agreed by the parties
