to secure him harmless and the said bond being for just base price of a lay house
was therefore this agreement made this 14th Jan'y 1851 between Meadison Williams of one
part and J. R. West of the other so it was with that the said Meadison Williams duly
gives the said West a lien on the said house and all my other chattel property of any kind
to secure him in said security ship and until the said house is paid for the said West shall
have the right to claim him as his own, allowing one to use him to work any crops.
