This Deed of bargain and sale made this 17th day of January A.D. 1881 between Benj. E. Norrell of the first part and Col. W. Williams of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Benj. E. Norrell in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) in hand paid by the said Col. Williams the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do give and convey with general warranty unto the said Col. Williams his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid and containing two hundred acres in the same more or less and bounded as follows Beginning at a set gum on each leading from Jerusalem to Jenkins mill from Bachmans mill to corner on the land of Col. John Bryants thence in a southerly direction to a branch then westerly on said branch along a line of choput trees some three hundred yards to a gum thence in South easterly direction along a straight line of choput trees to James H. Desonsy line thence S 85° E along a line of choput trees to Blackbushs mill thence thence along the said scabbles 1000 lbs thence S 66° E 1000 lbs to a Black gum corner in little Sluggys creek thence up the said creek to the gum leading to Jenkins mill thence along said creek to the beginning. There is no survey of the above land and I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 17th day of January A.D. 1881.
