Whereas a Deed of the Circuit Court of Southampton County in the chancery suit of Williams
against Patton & others, concluded at 10 o'clock on the 15th of Nov. 1890, said Williams was appointed commis-
sioner to sell the real estate belonging to Williams & Patton & sold, and the said Williams
according to the directions of said decree, sold the said real estate, and sold the same to the
highest bidder on the premises on the 20th day of November 1890 and at the sale so made Joseph
B. Prince became the purchaser of a part of said land described in two plat of survey made by
Geo. W. Spier, one tract known as the the home tract containing two hundred thirty five acres
and the other known as the Dutch Neck tract containing two hundred & twenty nine acres, which
said plat is hereunto returned as a part of this Deed, which said sale was reported to and
confirmed by the said Court, and so hereunto the said B. F. Williams was further authorized to collect
the whole of the said purchase money, when the same became due, and so hereunto to execute to the said
Prince a Deed with special warranty for the said land, and so hereunto the whole of the purchase money
has been paid. Now this Deed made this 21st day of December 1890 between B. F. Williams Commissioner
of the first part and Joseph B. Prince of the second part, witness that the said B. F. Williams for and in
consideration of the sum of eleven hundred & thirty one dollars to him in hand paid by the said Joseph
B. Prince the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth grant and bargain and sell unto the said
Joseph B. Prince with special warranty, the two tracts of land above described one tract containing
two hundred & thirty five acres & the other tract containing two hundred & twenty nine acres, the boundaries
of said tracts of land will fully appear by the plat of survey made by Geo. W. Spier and returned as
a part of this Deed, witness the following signatures and seal.
