


Witness by a decree of the Circuit Court of Buchanan County in the Chancery suit of Williams against Rolling and others, concluded at November Term 1893, that Williams was appointed Commissioner to sell the real estate belonging to William A. Rollings, doct, and the said W. Williams according to the directions of said decree, and in said the said real estate and sold the same to the highest bidder on the premises on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November 1893, and at the sale so made John B. Hille became the purchaser of a part of the said land by bidding there for the sum of five hundred & four dollars, the said part of said land is described in the bill of sale made by Geo. W. Sperry as tract containing one hundred & twenty nine acres and known as the Sam Ricks tract, and the other containing one hundred & twenty nine acres and known as Lydia Rollings tract which said tract is herewith returned as a part of the Deed, & which said sale, was reported to and confirmed by the said Court, and whereas the said W. Williams said further authorized to collect the whole of the purchase money, when the same became due, and when paid to consign to the said John B. Hille, as Deed for said land with special warranty, and whereas the whole of the purchase money has been paid, Now this Deed made this 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1894 between W. Williams Commissioner of the first part, and John B. Hille of the second part, Witnesseth that the said W. Williams for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred & four Dollars to him in hand paid by the said John B. Hille, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John B. Hille with special warranty, the Sam Ricks of before described tract containing one hundred & twenty nine acres, and the other tract containing one hundred & twenty nine acres, the boundaries of the said tract of land as fully set forth by the bill of sale made by the said Geo. W. Sperry, which is annexed hereto as a part of this Deed, with the following signatures and seal.
