This Deed, made and entered into this the 1st day of January in the year another and eight hundred and eighty one, between Eunice Garrison and Mary J. R. Garrison, his wife, of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia parties of the first part and William E. Myrick, party of the second part, witness that in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars, the said Eunice Garrison and Mary, his wife, do grant, bargain and sell, and by these presents convey unto the said William E. Myrick all of their title and interest in and to a certain parcel of land lying and being in Southampton County and containing one hundred and seventy one acres, in the same more or less) Boundaries as follows to wit, on the North by the lands of George H. Darlin and wife, on the South by Robert Edwards, Esq; East by the lands of William E. Myrick West by the lands of H. H. Stephenson and wife, during their joint or joint tenancy situated and being opposite the lands of the said William E. Myrick commonly known as the Rochelle Place and the place which was left and bequeathed to the Mary J. R. Garrison by Doctor J. P. Rochelle, her husband; And the said Eunice Garrison and Mary, his wife, covenant with the said William E. Myrick that they have done no act to encumber this instrument and to the said land and with execute such further assurance as may be requisite.
