This Deed made this ~~13th~~ first day of February 1881 between S. H. Bishop of Southampton County, State of Virginia of the one part, and R. D. Hudgins of the City of Richmond Va. of the other part, Witnesseth that the said S. H. Bishop doth grant unto the said R. D. Hudgins Trustee, the following property to wit: (to wit) twenty (20) horse power portable Engine on wheels (one) 3/4 saw mill complete with a full log carriage, two catch ~~h~~ head blocks connected by shafts and axle's each saw, also (1) lumber tract wheels and axle, purchased by said S. H. Bishop of William E. Pomeroy Esq. of Richmond Va. the deferred payments of the purchase of which this deed is given to secure, and trust to secure to William E. Pomeroy Esq. of the City of Richmond the payment of the four negotiable notes, all due to said S. H. Bishop and payable to Wm. E. Pomeroy Esq. bearing even date with this deed, for the following sums to wit: One note at four months from date for \$530.93 One note at eight months from date for \$530.93 One note at eleven months from date for \$530.93 One note at fourteen months from date for \$530.93 making a total sum of Twenty one hundred and twenty three \$3 No dollars in event of default on part of said S. H. Bishop, in making payment of either of the said notes as it shall become due and payable or upon breach of any of the covenants made and entered into by said S. H. Bishop in this deed, then the said Trustee on being required to do so by said William E. Pomeroy Esq. or either holder of said notes or either of them shall take possession of the property conveyed and after collecting in such manner as said Trustee shall deem best calculated to secure the debt paid therefor, shall sell the same at public auction and upon the following terms to wit: for cash or to so much of the proceeds as will be sufficient to pay the expenses of sale, and otherwise executing this trust and to discharge the amount of money then payable upon said notes, and if at the time of the delivery of said notes have not become due and payable, such part as parts of the said purchase as will be sufficient to pay off said notes as aforesaid shall be made payable at such time or times as it as they shall become due, the payment of said part or parts to be properly secured over the residue upon such times and to be secured in such manner as the said S.
