

And the said S^t Bishop further covenants and agrees with the said Director and William C. Farmer that the said Machinery hereinbefore mentioned when removed from the Works of said William C. Farmer will be carried directly to and located in the County of Southampton State of Virginia and in case said property is removed from said County the said S^t Bishop shall notify said William C. Farmer of such removal within thirty days thereafter and said S^t Bishop also covenants to pay all taxes assessments and dues upon said property hereby conveyed and shall keep the same fully insured for the benefit of said William C. Farmer so long as he or his assigns shall hold the same.

It is agreed and stipulated between M^r B. Chandler of the one part and Robert C. Ayres of the other that M^r B. Chandler shall furnish the land and one horse or mule and feed the same which horse or mule is to be used only about the crops for the purpose of making a crop for the year 1880 and that M^r B. Chandler shall have a crop lien on the whole crop for any advances made to Robert C. Ayres during the year for fertilizers furnished and for labor paid for about making the said crop or for securing and gathering it and that the said Robert C. Ayres shall deliver to M^r B. Chandler ready for market one half of the crop of corn cotton field peas and peanuts and shall pay him out of his one share for any advances made in money or provisions and it is further stipulated and agreed that Robert C. Ayres is to clear and put in cultivation one and a half acres of land and M^r B. Chandler is to pay one half the expense of clearing the same provided it does not exceed the sum of five dollars as witnessed the following signatures this 7th day of January 1880
