This Deed made this 24th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and
 eighty one between W. F. Bradehous and Elizabeth Bradehous his wife of the first part and L. C. Webb
 of the second part Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of \$1000⁰⁰ County five hundred
 Dollars the said W. F. Bradehous and Elizabeth Bradehous his wife do grant unto the said
 A. F. Webb and his heirs forever with general warranty all of a certain tract or parcel of land
 known as the W. F. Richardson tract with the exception of W. F. Bradehous and
 containing 279 1/2¹/₂ acres situated in the county of Southampton and bounded
 by the lands of W. F. Bradehous James J. Stone George H. Lawrence et al Johnson Barnes L. C. Webb
