Vick, the following real estate to wit, the tract of land known as the Rose Place lying in Southampton County, Virginia, containing six hundred and thirty acres by the common corner line and bounded by the lands of John L. Biggs, George E. Butler, Mr. Harris, Mr. A. Powell and Mr. S. Francis. The said William S. Francis conveints that he has the right to convey the said land to the grantees; that he has done no act to impair in the said land, that the grantees shall have quiet possession of the said land free from all incumbrance, and that he will execute such further assurances of the said land as may be requisite.
