This Deed made this 23rd day of December A.D. 1850. between R. P. Pope and Bettie D. Pope his wife of the first part and Mr. J. Seibull, Trustee of the estate part, all of Southampton County, Virginia. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five Dollars in hand paid by the said Trustee & the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said R. P. Pope and Bettie his wife de grant & convey to the said Mr. J. Seibull, Trustee as aforesaid, the following Real Estate to wit: The first mill and 15 acres of land thereto attached and with all buildings & fixtures thereon situated as the same belong known as Pope's mill, was the road leading from Jerusalem to Newcomer Depot, it being the same purchased by said R. P. Pope from his father J. P. Pope dead & Mr. Trust, however to secure the payment of the following notes to wit: A note to due G. D. Butler for \$611.60⁰⁰ payable with its interest till the 23rd of Dec. 1851, A note to due G. D. Butler for \$590⁰⁰ payable with its interest till the 23rd of December 1852, both of said notes being dated 23rd Dec. 1850.

Deal grantee the following property to wit: Six hundred bushels of peas, fifty barrels of corn and three hundred lbs of potatoes and twenty five hundred lbs of pork, to him and his heirs forever.
