

Deed of Trust  
recorded in Deed Book  
from 1875 to 1880  
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Munse by trust Deed dated April 31<sup>st</sup> 1879 and of record in the Deeds Office of Southampton Jones H. Peters did convey unto J. B. Prince trustee a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton State of Virginia containing One hundred and forty nine acres being under tracts and known as the Home tract and Miller tract and bounded by the lands of W. D. Clemente on the North, on the East by Mrs. Robert and the South by S. P. C. and N. T. Chitty, and in the West by Jas. D. Prince, special reference being made to trust deed in trust to receive a sum for Seven Hundred Dollars dated April 31<sup>st</sup> 1877 due to B. E. Norrell and where the said debt has been fully paid to the said B. E. Norrell by the said John H. Peters as is evidenced by the said Norrell signing reciting this deed, And in consideration of the above mentioned premise the said parties Jas. D. Prince and B. E. Norrell do grant and convey with special warranty unto the said John H. Peters the aforesaid tract of land situated as aforesaid free from and discharged of the lien of the aforesaid trust deed.
