Driver, in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, for and in consideration of Eighteen hundred and sixty four of the Stock of goods hereinafter to be described, the receipt whereof I the said Ottilie J. Driver do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell, unto Mr. P. Lamb, the entire Stock of goods and fixtures in the Store house on Main Street in the Town of Franklin, known as the Melbourn Store in which I, through R. M. Driver my agent, was conducting the grocery business, the said stock consisting of Groceries, Shells, goods, Liquors, Tobacco, sugar, Beans, fixtures, Store fixtures, Tools, notes, accounts and every thing pertaining to said Store for, and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred and sixty four dollars, to have, and to hold, the said granted and bargained goods unto the said Mr. P. Lamb his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns to have and hold for his own proper use, benefit and behoof forever, and I the said Ottilie J. Driver do verily hereby, to be the true and lawful owner of the goods, and effects, hereby sold, and to have in himself full power good right and lawful authority, to dispose of the said goods in manner as aforesaid, and I do for myself, my heirs, administrators and assigns, hereby covenant and agree to warrant and defend the said goods and chattels, as aforesaid mentioned sold unto the said Mr. P. Lamb his heirs, Executors, administrators, and assigns against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, whomsoever, In witness whereof the said Ottilie J.
