Driver do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto Mr. P. Lamb, the entire stock of goods and fixtures in the Store house on main street in the Town of Franklin known as Melbourns Store in which I, through R. M. Driver my agent, was conducting the grocery business, the said stock consisting of Groceries Sherry goods Liquors Tobacco sugar Beans fixtures Store fixtures Books, notes accounts and every thing pertaining to said Store for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred and sixty four dollars, to have and to hold, the said granted and bargained goods unto the said Mr. P. Lamb his heirs Executors administrators and assigns to have and hold for his own proper use benefit and behoof forever, and to the said Otilia J. Driver do vouch herself to be the true and lawful owner of the goods and effects hereby sold, and to have in herself full power good right and lawful authority, to dispose of the said goods in manner as aforesaid and to do for myself, my heirs administrators and assigns, hereby covenant and agree to warrant and defend the said goods and chattels, as aforesaid mentioned sold unto the said Mr. P. Lamb his heirs Executors administrators, and assign against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, whomsoever, in witness whereof the said Otilia J. Driver hereunto sets her hand and seal this the eighteenth day of February A.D. Eighteen hundred and eighty one.
