

This Deed of Bargain & Sale made this the 30th day of December 1880 between
 E. L. Turner and Alice O. Turner of the County of Southampton State of
 Virginia granters of the first part, and William H. Pittman of same County
 and State grantees of second part to wit: That in consideration of the sum of
 six hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Pittman the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged by the said E. L. Turner and Alice O. Turner do grant,
 convey bargain & sell with general warranty unto the said Pittman a certain
 parcel of land being and situated in the Town of Franklin County
 aforesaid and bounded as follows commencing at the north west corner
 of 1st avenue and Pine Street thence west along 1st avenue 46 feet to lot no 22
 owned by Mrs. Mary A. Rager thence north along a parallel with Pine Street
 210 feet to 2nd avenue thence a boundary between this lot and Mrs. Rager's
 lot thence east along 2nd avenue 46 feet to Pine Street thence south along
 Pine Street 210 feet to 1st avenue the point of beginning containing a little
 less than 1/4 acre more or less. And the said Turner & O. Turner do covenant to make
 any further assurances necessary to convey unto the said Pittman together with
 all rights, improvements and appurtenances therunto belonging this lot is the one purchased by said Turner by Deed
 of Bargain & Sale dated Dec 7th from John Prindle & Co. and in which there is
 a deed of trust to secure to said Prindle the purchase price of said lot and is
 known on a map of Franklin as lot no 27. This matter is made subject to the provisions
 of said Deed of Trust, to wit: the following signature and seal.
