

This Deed made this 4<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year 1880 between H. R. Griffin  
 trustee of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part  
 and J. E. P. Turner of said County and State of the second part, Whereas Jno W.  
 Harrison now deceased, did by a certain deed of trust bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of  
 June 1876 and recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Court of Southampton County,  
 grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Jno R. Hill, trustee, all that certain tract  
 of land lying in the County aforesaid containing 2.3 acres & the same more or less  
 and bounded by the lands of Jelle & Rogers Estate, Wm. A. Joyner and others, the  
 same being land formerly owned by Geo L. James in trust to remain to Miss  
 Nannie Ethridge & Brooks of the City of Port Royal with the payment of a debt  
 due by bond for the sum of \$1150<sup>C</sup> bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1876, and  
 whereas the said Jno W. Harrison made default and failed to pay the aforesaid  
 sum of money, the said H. R. Griffin trustee appointed as such by the  
 County Court of Southampton County at the November term thereof as  
 substitute trustee in the place of Jno R. Hill deceased, as will be seen  
 by reference to the record of the County Court of Southampton County, did on the 14<sup>th</sup>  
 day of December 1880 after giving due notice of time and the place of sale  
 by advertising the same in the Franklin Gazette and by posting the same  
 before the local house door of Southampton County, and at several other  
 public places in said County, sell at public auction to the highest bidder at Branch-  
 ville, in said County for cash, the tract of land herein before fully described  
 together with all the improvements thereon appertaining belonging thereto, at  
 which sale the said J. E. P. Turner became the purchaser thereof, bidding  
 the sum of \$1350<sup>C</sup> and that being the highest bid, now therefore this deed  
 witnesseth that the said H. R. Griffin trustee, in performance of his duties as  
 trustee, and for and in consideration of the said sum \$1350<sup>C</sup> to him in  
 hand paid by the said J. E. P. Turner, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,  
 doth grant and convey unto the said J. E. P. Turner, with special warranty the  
 tract of land mentioned and described above as lying in the County of  
 Southampton, containing 2.3 acres & the same more or less, and bounded by  
 the lands of Jelle & Rogers Estate, Wm. A. Joyner and others, the same being the  
 tract of land conveyed by Jno W. Harrison deceased to Jno R. Hill trustee  
 for the benefit of Nannie Ethridge & Brooks which due reference is  
 made for further description of the land herein conveyed.
