This Deed made this the first day of February A.D. 1891 between S. H. Bishop and his wife Harriett Bishop of Southampton County, Virginia, of the one part, and R. D. Hudgins of the City of Richmond, State of Virginia, of the other part, witnesseth that the said S. H. Bishop and wife doth grant and convey unto the said R. D. Hudgins, Trustee, the following property, to wit: A tract or parcels of land known as the Edwards tract containing two hundred and sixty acres, bounded by lands of P. D. Story, Thomas Bishop, S. H. Bishop & others. An abstract known as part of the Bellitt tract of land, containing one hundred and forty acres, bounded by the lands of Wm. Riddle, David Vick, and J. L. Bishop, both of said tracts lying in Southampton County, Va. and both sides of the road leading from J. L. Bishop store to Cypress bridge together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging. In Deed to secure to Wm. C. Ramsey & Co. of Richmond Va. the payment of the four negotiable notes, all drawn by the said S. H. Bishop, and payable to Wm. C. Ramsey bearing in date with this deed for the following sums, viz. One note at four months from date for \$530.88. One note at eight months from date for \$530.88. One note at eleven months from date for \$530.88. One note at fourteen months from date for \$530.88, making a total sum of twenty one hundred, twenty, three & 3/100 dollars. In event of default on the part of the said S. H. Bishop, in making payment of either of the said notes as it shall become due and payable, then the said Trustee upon being required so to do by said Wm. C. Ramsey & Co. or either holder of said notes or either of them, shall after legal advertisement, sell the same at public auction for cash at the Court house door in the town of Jerusalem Va. and shall apply the proceeds of such sale to the discharge of the amount of money then due upon said notes, and shall pay the balance if any to the said S. H. Bishop or his legal representatives, Witness the following signature and seals
