that in consideration of a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars to be  
advanced by James McCorbit in money, provisions and fertilizer in  
such proportion of each as the said Leavon Beal may request now  
wherefore this contract witnesseth that in consideration of the said sum  
of five hundred dollars by the said James McCorbit advanced during  
the year 1881 the said Leavon Beal doth give to the said James McCorbit  
a crop claim on the crop of corn, fodder, cotton, pumpkins, and such other  
crops as he may plant, grow, gather and reap on his lands in Southam-  
pton County as witness the signature of Leavon Beal the 16<sup>th</sup> of March 1881

A W Rivers the Rail road ties and cord wood near the tract of the  
Subard and Roanoke rail road when required so to do as witness the
