This Deed, made the 10th day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty and
 between William H Jenkins of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia
 of the first part, and John Bowers Doan Crumpler Geo L Holmes Charles B
 Crumpler Charles B Joyner (Deacons) Dr Jno L Griffin and Alfred D Stephenson (Trustees)
 for the Baptist Church known as the Tucker Swamp Baptist Church in the County
 of Southampton and State of Virginia of the second part, Witnesseth, that in
 consideration of the sum of one cent, and in the further consideration of the love good
 will and friendly regard which the said Wm H Jenkins has for the said Church, the
 said William H Jenkins do grant, with general warranty, unto the said John
 Bowers Doan Crumpler Geo L Holmes Charles B Crumpler Charles B Joyner, Dr
 Jno L Griffin and Alfred D Stephenson Trustees for the aforesaid Tucker Swamp
 Baptist Church situated as aforesaid all that lot or parcel of land situated in
 the County of Southampton and State of Virginia bounded and described as
 follows, commencing on the County Road leading from Juni to Branches
 Bridge at corner and the lot or parcel of land belonging to the aforesaid Tucker
 Swamp Baptist Church thence a line along said lot to a post mark a point on
 Jno L Griffin, thence a line of marked trees back to the said County Road to a
 marked point or corner on the said Jno L Griffin, thence along said County
 Road to the corner on the lot belonging to the aforesaid Church, it being the point
 beginning, containing 200 acres more or less and the said lot or parcel of land
 is triangularly shaped, it is covenanted that this lot of two acres more or less is to be
 used solely for the benefit of the aforesaid Church for a cemetery, or burying ground, or
 for any other purpose which in the judgement of the Trustees aforesaid or their
 successors may be deemed best for the interest of the aforesaid Church, the said William
 H Jenkins covenants that he has the right to convey the said land to the grantee, that
 he has done no act to encumber the said land, that the grantee shall have quiet
 possession of the said land, free from all encumbrances, and that the said party of
 the first part will execute such further assurance of the said land as may be requested.
