Excerpts

I do hereby Deed and convey to Wm Norfleet my part of the second part, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to the said G R Edwards and J P Bryant in hand paid by the said Indicima W Norfleet, the receipt of which said sum is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey, with special warranty, unto the said Indicima W Norfleet all that certain lot or parcel of land situated in the said town of Franklin in said County, an acre and a half being forty feet long and fifty seven feet wide (80x57 ft) and is bounded by the lots of John Jones & George and the said John Pitts Jr: it being the same lot which was conveyed by the said John Pitts Jr: by Deed recorded in the Clerks Office of the County Court of said County on the day of 187, to the said G R Edwards & J P Bryant, as Trustees for the benefit of an Episcopal church thereafter to be built, organized and established in the said town of Franklin. And whereas the said Episcopal church thus contemplated has never as yet been built, established or organized, and whereas it is considered by the parties of the first part that another location in the said town of Franklin will be more desirable for the said church, which said last named location the said John Pitts Jr: has agreed to set to the said Trustees for the said sum of fifty dollars. Now this Deed witnesseth that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to the said Indicima W Norfleet the lot of land before mentioned and described to be held and disposed of by her by last will and testament, by Deed of Bargain & Sale, mortgages as otherwise as if she were a free sole subject to the laws of Virginia. The said John Pitts not setting up any right title or interest in as to this said lot has joined in this Deed only for the purpose of perfecting Mrs Norfleet's title to the same, Witness the following signatures to witness.
