This Deed made this 24th day of April 1880 between John Pitlor Jr. of the County of Southampton State of Virginia grantor of the first part and Indiana V. Norfleet of the same County and State of the second part witnesses that the said John Pitlor Jr. in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth grant bargain sell and convey with general warranty unto the said Indiana V. Norfleet the following real property to wit: 1st a certain parcel of land lying and situated in the Town of Franklin and bounded as follows: on the North by 8th Avenue commencing at the eastern intersection of the eastern boundary of a lot of land belonging to Jonas W. Lawrence, and on the east side of Adams Street, with said 3rd Avenue thence along said Avenue in an easterly direction about 27 feet to a lot belonging to John B. B. thence in a southerly direction along the western boundary of said B. B. lot, 130 feet thence in a westerly direction along a line parallel with 3rd Avenue to said Jonas W. Lawrence lot about 27 feet, thence in a southerly direction along said Jonas W. Lawrence eastern boundary 130 feet to 3rd Avenue the point of beginning containing by estimation $\frac{1}{4}$ acre more or less, said lot being a part of
