This Deed made this 24 day of February in the year 1881, between Jesse P. Haucum and Virginia his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, and George A. Beale of said County and State of the second part, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred and fifty seven dollars to them in hand paid by the said Geo. A. Beale, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, thus, the said parties of the first part, do grant bargain, sell and convey, unto the said party of the second part, subject to a Deed of Trust executed on the 19th day of May 1877 by the said parties of the first part to secure to Wm. Beale the payment of five hundred dollars, all that certain tract of land lying in the County and State aforesaid about three miles South of the town of Franklin, and bounded on the North by the lands of M. W. Holland, on the South by the lands of William Beale, on the East by the lands of Carr Beale and on the West by the Franklin and South Lucy County road, A part of the same tract of land conveyed by Wm.
