This Agreement entered into this the 21 day of March 1881 between Joshua H. Powell of the one part and William Stith of the other part, both parties of the State of Virginia of Southampton County, Witness with that whereas the said William Stith is about to engage in the cultivation of the Lands owned by Jos. H. Powell, and desires to obtain in ^{supplies} from the said Jos. H. Powell to the amt of one hundred & twenty five Dollars, beyond which limit the said William Stith shall not go, and the said Jos. H. Powell on his part doth agree to furnish the said advances. Now the said William Stith on his part in consideration of the above promise doth hereby grant alien to the Joshua H. Powell, upon all crops that may be made on the Lands cultivated by the said William Stith during the year 1881, the said William Stith further agrees to deliver to the said Jos. H. Powell all cotton and other produce made on said lands during the year 1881 to satisfy all claims that he Jos. H. Powell may hold against the said William Stith. If for all claims be settled, had of said proceeds is to be paid over to the said William Stith on his assignor. The said William Stith further agrees that said lands shall be worked in good order, if not the said Jos. H. Powell is to hire hands & have it done and charge the expenses to the said William Stith. This lien is granted under an act of the general Assembly of 1878. Approved & passed 2nd Feb^y 1873. Entitled an act to secure advances for agricultural purposes. Witness the following signatures,

Powell of one part and Anthony Mason of the other part, both parties of the State of Virginia and County of Southampton, Witness with that whereas the said Anthony Mason is about to engage in the cultivation of the Lands owned by the said Jos. H. Powell, and desires to obtain during the year 1881, advances in ^{supplies} from the said Jos. H. Powell to the amt of one hundred & twenty five Dollars, beyond which limit the said Anthony Mason shall not go, and the said Joshua H. Powell having agreed on his part to furnish the said advances upon the said Anthony Mason on his part in consideration of the above promise doth hereby grant a lien to the said Joshua H. Powell, upon all crops that may be made on the Lands cultivated by the said Anthony Mason during the year 1881. The said Anthony Mason further agrees to deliver to the said Jos. H. Powell all cotton and other produce made on said lands during the year 1881 to satisfy all claims that the said Jos. H. Powell may hold against the said Anthony Mason and after all claims be settled balance of said proceeds is to be paid over to the said Anthony Mason or his assignor. The said Anthony Mason further agrees that said lands shall be worked in good order, if not the said Jos. H. Powell is to hire hands & have it done and charge expenses of said hands to the said Anthony Mason. This lien is
