This Agreement entered into this the 21 day of March 1881 between Joshua H. Powell  
 of the one part and William Stith of the other part, both parties of the State of  
 Va. & of Southampton County, Wttneswth that wheras the said William Stith is about to  
 engage in the cultivation of the Lands owned by Joe H. Powell, and desirous to  
 claim during the year 1881, Advance in Spply from the said Joe H. Powell  
 to the amt of one hundred & Twenty five Dollars, beyond which limit the said  
 William Stith shall not go, and the said Joe H. Powell on his part doth agree to  
 furnish the said advance, & to the said William Stith on his part in consideration  
 of the above promise doth hereby grant a lien to the Joshua H. Powell, upon all crops  
 that may be made on the Lands cultivated by the said William Stith during the  
 year 1881, the said William Stith further agrees to deliver to the said Joe H. Powell  
 all cotton and other produce made on said lands during the year 1881 to satisfy  
 all claims that he Joe H. Powell may hold against the said William Stith, & after all  
 claims be settled, half of said produce is to be paid over to the said William Stith or  
 his assignee, the said William Stith further agrees that said lands shall be worked  
 in good order, if not the said Joe H. Powell is to have hands & have it done and charge  
 the expense to the said William Stith. This lien is granted under an act of the  
 General Assembly of Va. Approved April 2<sup>nd</sup> 1873 Entitld an Act to secure

 by the said Joe H. Powell, and is desirous to claim during the year 1881, Advance  
 in Spply, from the said Joe H. Powell to the amt of one hundred & Twenty five  
 Dollars, beyond which limit the said Anthony Mason shall not go, & the said  
 Joshua H. Powell having agreed on his part to furnish the said advances, now  
 the said Anthony Mason further agrees to deliver to the said  
 Joe H. Powell all cotton and other produce made on said lands during  
 the the year 1881, to satisfy all claims that the said Joe H. Powell may hold  
 against the said Anthony Mason and after all claims be settled balance  
 of said produce is to be paid over to the said Anthony Mason or his assignee,  
 the said Anthony Mason further agrees that said lands shall be worked  
 in good order, if not the said Joe H. Powell is to have hands & have it done  
 and charge expense of said lands to the said Anthony Mason. This lien is
