 & Co of one part and Job Holland, E B Holland and George D Holland of the  
 other part witnesseth, That whereas the said Job Holland, E B Holland and  
 George D Holland are about to engage in the cultivation of this soil and con-  
 sider it necessary during the year 1881 advances in supplies from the said  
 W H Burton & Co to the amount of one hundred and twenty five Dollars,  
 beyond which limit the said Job Holland, E B Holland and George D Holland  
 shall not go and the said W H Burton & Co having agreed to furnish  
 the said advances, now the said Job Holland, E B Holland and George D Holland  
 on their part in consideration of the above premises do hereby grant a lien to the  
 said W H Burton & Co on the crops which may be made during the year 1881 upon  
 the lands in cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been given  
 intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an Act of the  
 General Assembly of Virginia Approved April 2<sup>d</sup> 1873 intituled An Act to
