Beaton & Co having agreed on their part to furnish the said advances, now the said Job Holland, E. B. Holland and George D. Holland on their part in consideration of the above premises do hereby grant a lien to the said W. M. Beaton & Co on that crop which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands in cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended.
