This Agreement entered into this 25th day of February 1881 between Geo W. Rumer and J. E. R. Rumer, merchants and partners trading under the firm name of Rumer & Bro. of one part and William A. Jones, late of E. Jones (his wife) N. Edwards Jones of the other part witnesses that whereas the said William A. Jones late of E. Jones (his wife) N. Edwards Jones are about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and are desirous to obtain during the year 1881 advances in money or supplies for the said Rumer & Bro. to the amount of one hundred dollars, beyond which limit the said William A. Jones late of E. Jones (his wife) shall not go; and the said Rumer & Bro. having agreed on their part to furnish the said advances, now the said William A. Jones late of E. Jones (his wife) N. Edwards Jones on their part, in consideration of the above premises do hereby grant a lien to the said Rumer & Bro. on the crops which may be made during the year 1881 whatever may be due for rent for said year upon the land on the cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2. 1873 entitled An Act to secure advances for agriculturists. Witnesses the following signatures and seals

Whereas John S. Hubbard of Southampton County is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and desires to obtain during the year 1881 advances in supplies to the amount of one hundred and fifty dollars; and whereas J. S. Thomas of said County does hereby agree to furnish him to an amount not exceeding said sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, now therefore this Agreement made and entered into this 22nd day of January 1881 between said Hubbard and said Thomas witnesses that said Hubbard does hereby give and grant to said Thomas a lien on all crops which may be grown by said Hubbard in 1881 to secure payment for advances aforesaid, as provided in Chapter 363 of an Act of the General Assembly of 1872-73 to secure advances &c. The said Hubbard further agrees hereby to deliver to said Thomas as soon as practicable after the said crops shall have been secured so much of same as may be sufficient to pay for the advances aforesaid.
