This Agreement entered into this 25th day of February 1881 between Geo W. Remond and
 J. E. Remond merchants and factors trading under the firm name of Remond Bros.
 of Lawrence and William A. Jones & S. E. Jones (his wife), Edward Jones of the other
 part witness that whereas the said William A. Jones & S. E. Jones his wife Edward
 Jones are about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and are desirous to obtain during
 the year 1881 advances or money or supplies for the said Remond Bros. to the amount of
 One hundred Dollars by which time the said William A. Jones & S. E. Jones
 his wife ^{Edward Jones} shall go and the said Remond Bros. having agreed with their part to furnish the
 said advances, now the said William A. Jones & S. E. Jones his wife Edward Jones
 another party in consideration of the above premises do hereby grant a lien to the said Remond
 Bros. as the crops which may be made during the year 1881 also whatever may be due for rent
 for said year upon the land in the cultivation of which the above amount of advances
 has been or was intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an Act of the
 General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873 intituled An Act to secure advances

 County does hereby agree to furnish him to an amount not exceeding a sum of
 one hundred and fifty dollars, hereof, therefore this Agreement made and entered into
 this 23rd day of January 1881 between said Hubbard and said Thomas witness
 that said Hubbard does hereby give and grant to said Thomas a lien on all crops
 which may be grown by said Hubbard in 1881 to secure payment for advances
 aforesaid as provided in Chapter 863 of an act of the General Assembly of
 1872-73 to secure advances &c. The said Hubbard further agrees hereby to allow
 to said Thomas as soon as practicable after said crops shall have been harvested
 so much of same as may be sufficient to pay for the advances aforesaid
 given under our hands and seals this day and year above written
