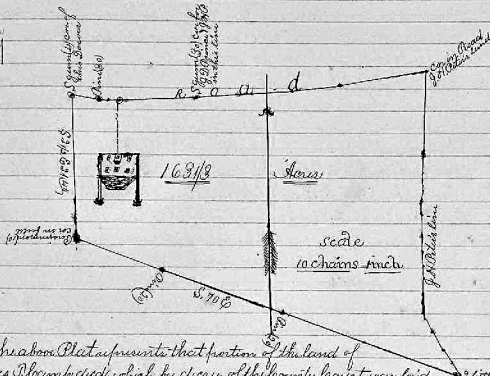

Camp died, which by decree of the County Court was laid off as the Dower of the widow of said Camp, said land is situated in the County of Southampton State of Virginia adjoining the lands of J. H. Peters, J. A. Prince and the estate of Geo. B. Camp, containing one hundred and sixty three 1/3 acres Surveyed June 7th 1879

At a Court held for the County of Southampton at the Court house thereof on Monday the 21st day of June 1880, the Commissioners appointed at the September Term 1879 of this Court to assign to Margaret M. Camp widow of Geo. B. Camp her Dower in the Real estate in this County whereof her said husband Geo. B. Camp died seized, that day made this report which is ordered to be filed & continued for for execution, And at a Court held for said County on this 21st day of March 1881 the said report having been read and upwards in the Clerk's Office and no objections being filed thereto it was examined and confirmed by the Court and ordered to be recorded and it was ordered that the said Margaret M. Camp have the said land to her assigned and for her Dower.
