Whereas by trust deed dated Augt 20th 1877 a note of record in the Clerks Office of Southampton, J. L. Barkham and wife did convey and grant unto J. D. Darden trustee a certain parcel of land containing 54 acres, near Newcomes Depot, in trust to execute bonds due by said Barkham to H. P. Pope, and whereas the bonds have been fully paid as is evidenced by J. B. Prince Esq'r of Newcomes, H. P. Pope, who held the said bonds, becoming a party to this deed signing and sealing the same and whereas the said Barkham is now entitled to a release of the said land from the lien of the aforesaid trust deed, now therefore this deed made this 25th day of March 1881 between J. D. Darden trustee, and J. B. Prince Esq'r of H. P. Pope's part and J. L. Barkham of his part witnesseth that in consideration of the above facts, the said parties of the first part do grant & convey with special warranty unto the said J. L.
