

This Deed made this the eighteenth day of June in the year eighteen hundred & twenty seven between J^d Pultro & Mary J^d Pultro his wife of the first part & Benjamin C. Cobb of the second part all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, Witnesses that in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said J^d Pultro & Mary J^d Pultro his wife parties of the first part do grant & convey to the said Benjamin Cobb and their right title & interest to a certain piece of land supposed to contain five acres more or less the said land lying on the Eastern front of J^d Pultro's farm on which he now lives & being a part of the land of said J^d Pultro which was cut off from his farm by the new road running from Princeton meeting house to Franklin & is bounded on the East by the land of the said Benjamin Cobb North by a Swamp & bordering their land from J^d Pultro's part of some piece out of his road the sum of which branch is to be the dividing line & West & South by the land of J^d Pultro the said five acres of land being in the shape of a triangle & this said J^d Pultro & Mary J^d Pultro his wife do warrant the title to the said land generally & that they will make such other covenants if any as may be necessary to give said possession to said land, Witness the foregoing signatures & seals this the day & date above written.

This Deed made this 14th day of February 1881 between N L Gordon and Betty J his wife of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the first part and J^d Pultro of same County and State of the second part Witnesses that the said N L Gordon and wife do grant and convey with general warranty unto the said J^d Pultro the following real property to wit: a certain parcel or lot of land in the Town of Princeton on the South side of Clay street and bounded as follows commencing at the Northwest corner of John Pultro's lot, an alley street thence along said street in a westerly direction one hundred and fifty feet to a street or lane between the lot herein described and a lot belonging to J N Boggs thence along said lane or street three hundred feet to J^d Pultro's & thence land thence along said land in a southeasterly direction one hundred and fifty feet to said John Pultro's lot thence in an easterly direction a long said John Pultro's lot thence three hundred feet to Clay Street the point of beginning, it being the
