This Deed, made the 31st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
eighty one between Joseph Joyner of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one
part and Merritt L. Raiford of City of Nottoway County and State of the other part, witnesseth,
That the said Joseph Joyner in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars doth
grant, with general warranty, unto the said Merritt L. Raiford and his heirs and assigns
forever, the following several estates, to wit: All that certain tract or parcel of land known as
the old Corbit tract, situated in Southampton County in said State of Virginia and
containing Thirty seven (37) acres more or less (the family burial ground being excepted
and reserved), and bounded on the North by the land of Wiley Duck on the South by
the land of Geo. Turner on the East by the land of Gile Raiford and on the West by the
land of Alpheus Harris or his wife, and being the same land which by deed dated the 21st
day of February 19 1881 and recorded the 21st day of March 1881 was conveyed to
said Joseph Joyner by Jas. H. Corbit and wife, together with all and singular the
appurtenances belonging to the same at the time of the said Joseph Joyner's conveyance that he
has the right to convey the said land to the grantees, that the said grantees shall have quiet
possession of said land, that he has done no act to encumber the said land, and that
he will execute such further conveyances of the said land as may be required.
