Bryant is engaged, or is about to engage, in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said Robt S. Pope shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which said Robt S. Pope has agreed to do, Now this agreement Witnesseth, That the said Robt S. Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Martha P. Bryant during the present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of ~~One hundred~~ fifty dollars in amount, as may be needed to enable the said Martha P. Bryant to be cultivated and gather her crops, proper to be made the present year, And the said Martha P. Bryant hereby gives and grants to the said Robt S. Pope, a lien upon all crops that she may make on the lands which she here, or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton, during the present year to wit, Corn, Potatoes, Rice, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops, in and to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum
