make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil, which said Robt S.
Pope has agreed to do, now this agreement Witnesseth that the said Robt S.
Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said
Maitha P. Bryant during the present year, such money, provisions, fuel, tools
and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Three hundred and no dollars
