This Agreement made this 26th day of March in the year 1881, between Ben Evans of Southampton County, of the first, and Robt S Pope of Southampton County, of the second part, of the State of Virginia, Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Ben Evans is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said Robt S Pope shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, to which said Robt S Pope has agreed to do, Now this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said Robt S Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Ben Evans during the present year, such Monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Three hundred & Fifty Dollars in amount, as may be useful to enable the said Ben Evans to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year, and the said Ben Evans hereby gives and grants to the said Robt S Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has, or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton, during the present year, to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated, This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1873.
