This Agreement made this 11th day of April in the year 1881, between Andrew Joyner of Southampton County, of the first part, and R. S. Pope of Southampton County, of the second part, of the State of Virginia, Witness us forever, Whereas the said Andrew Joyner is engaged in, or is about to engage in the cultivation of the said land, is desirous that the said R. S. Pope should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which said R. S. Pope has agreed to do, And this Agreement Witnesseth, That the said R. S. Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Andrew Joyner, during the present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of One hundred and sixty three dollars in amount) as may be useful to enable the said Andrew Joyner to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year, And the said Andrew Joyner hereby gives and grants to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has, or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton, during the present year to wit, Corn, Rye, Peas, Potatoes, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of Law No. 1 of the General Assembly of Virginia, passed April 2, 1872. Witness our hands, this 11th day of April, 1881.

This Agreement made this 27th day of April in the year 1881, between Able Bloss of Southampton County, of the first part, and R. S. Pope of Southampton County, of the second part, of the State of Virginia, Witnesseth as follows: Whereas said Able Bloss is engaged in, and is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said R. S. Pope should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which said R. S. Pope has agreed to do. Now this agreement Witnesseth that the said R. S. Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Able Bloss during the present year, such Monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Two hundred & forty \$400 dollars in amount) as may be useful to enable the said Able Bloss to cultivate and gather his crops and provide to make the present year and the said Able Bloss hereby gives and grants to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has, or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton during the present year, to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Plums, Cotton and such other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1875. Witness our hand, this 27th day of April 1881.
