This Agreement made this 8th day of April in the year 1881 between Charles Bloss of Southampton County, of the first part, and R S Pope of Southampton County, of the second part, of the State of Virginia, Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Charles Bloss is engaged in, or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said R S Pope should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, and ~~in which said R S Pope has agreed to do~~, Now this Agreement Witnesseth That the said R S Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Charles Bloss, during the present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Three hundred thirty seven Five dollars in amount) as may be needed to enable the said Charles Bloss to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year, and the said Charles Bloss hereby gives and grants to the said R S Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make in the lands which he has, or may have, cultivated in the County of Southampton, during the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 8th day of April 1881

This Agreement made this 11th day of April in the year 1881 between J P Blaud of the first part, and R S Lewis of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said R S Lewis is engaged in, or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said J P Blaud should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, and in which the said J P Blaud has agreed to do, Now this Agreement Witnesseth That the said J P Blaud doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said R S Lewis during the present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Forty dollars in amount) as may be needed to enable the said R S Lewis to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year, and the said R S Lewis hereby gives and grants to the said J P Blaud a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above
