This Deed made this first day of April 1881 between Jas H Cole of the first part and Jno W Waller of the second part, witnesseth that in consideration of Fifty dollars the said Jas H Cole doth grant unto the said Jno W Waller with general warranty a certain lot situated near Boylston Depot, containing one half acre to the said Jno W Waller on the west side of the road leading from Boylston Depot to Mayfield. It is the boundaries of said lot being as follows, to wit, commencing at a public road and running South along such road to a stake now a long ditch which crosses the said public road. The distance from the commencement to the said stake being thirty five rods. Thence southerly in a straight course another stake thirty four rods North to a stone set by H. H. Hill. Thence along the line of said lot, being situated directly opposite the land owned by Ed. Barden conveyed to him in the year 1878 by Jas. B. Hamill his son, the said Jas H Cole covenants that he has the right to convey the said land to the greatest that he has done no act to encumber the said land, that the grants above have quiet possession of the said land free from all encumbrances and that the said Jas H Cole party of the first part will execute such further conveyance of the said land as may be requisite. Know all men by these presents that I S P Bain and S E Bain the wife of the said S P Bain of Wakefield, County of Sussex, and State of Virginia for and in consideration of the sum of one cent (1c) to me paid by the Deacons of Poor Christian Church, J W Brittle, L C Brittle, J W Brittle Jr, Thomas Griffin, Charles Rush and L R Rawls, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do give grant, sell and convey unto the said Trustees one acre of land to hold in trust for the aforesaid Poor Christian Church, lying moreover, about a quarter of a mile off the A 67 O P Road bounded on the North by the Poor and Jerusalem road East by S P Bain, South by L P Bain, West by S P Bain to him and to hold the same to the said Trustees and their successors to hold in trust for the aforesaid Poor Christian Church and its uses forever and the said S P Bain and S E Bain covenant with the said Trustees, their successors &c that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises that they are free from all incumbrances that I have good right to sell the same of myself and that I will warrant and defend the same to the said Trustees and their successors against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, In testimony thereof the said S P Bain have hereunto set my hand and seal this 13<sup>th</sup> day of
