This Deed made this 28th day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and
eighty, between W. H. Holmes of the one part, and W. H. Morris of the other part, witnesses,
that whereas on the 16th day of March 1878, Lewis and Morris sons Lewis his wife
by this Deed duly recorded, did convey unto the said W. H. Morris and the said W. H.
Holmes, parties in and under the title of W. H. Morris & Son, certain property
in the said deed mentioned, and hereinafter more particularly described, and whereas
the said partnership is hereby dissolved by the withdrawal of the said W. H. Holmes
therefrom and the said W. H. Holmes for clear good and sufficient reasons and
considerations him hereunto waiving, desires to surrender and convey his interest
under the Deed of March 16th 1878 above mentioned, to the said W. H. Morris, Now therefore
this Deed Witnesseth that the said W. H. Holmes for and in consideration of the premises
and of the sum of Five dollars to him in hand paid by the said W. H. Morris, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth grant unto the said W. H. Morris, the following lot
of land situated in the town of Franklin Southampton County, Va. with the
buildings thereon, bounded and described as follows, to wit: all the east side of
Main Street, beginning at the North side corner of the lot on which J. H. Butcher's
Store house now stands, and running thence along said Street North 32 1/2 feet
to Francis Williams lot, thence East, along the line of said lot to the lot formerly
owned by M. C. Council, thence South to the said J. H. Butcher's lot, thence West
along the line of the said lot to Main Street, the point of beginning, being the same
lot sold by Lewis & Morris as above stated to the said W. H. Morris and W. H. Holmes,
