This Agreement made this 13th day April 1861 between Dancy Leaborn and J. H. B. Prince
Witness that in as much as said Dancy Leaborn is engaged in agriculture and desires
a loan and a supply to an amount not exceeding twenty five dollars and one 1/10
Star Brand mules, and whereas the said J. H. B. Prince are willing I have agreed
to furnish said Dancy Leaborn to an amount not exceeding twenty five dollars and
one 1/10 Star Brand mules, Now therefore the said Dancy Leaborn hereby gives & grants
a lien to said J. H. B. Prince upon all his crops Cotton Corn fodder &c. &c. the manner
to be paid for with one 1/10 bale Cotton weighing 112 1/2 lbs each to grade middling &c. delivered
at Beaufort by Nov 1st 1861 and the said Dancy Leaborn also gives a lien upon his horse
