This Deed made this 12th day of April 1881 between I Lewis and Martha I his wife of
 one part and W. W. Briggs Trustee of second part Witnesseth That in consideration of
 Five dollars in hand paid the said parties of the first part do grant and convey with
 general warranty unto the said Trustee the following real estate to wit: a certain tract
 of land in Southampton County containing 1400 acres, be the same more or less, bounded
 by the lands of James B. Lewis, John Lewis, John Lewis & others, some being tract
 of land upon which the said Lewis now live. On Trust however to secure a bond
 for twenty five hundred dollars due by said Lewis to J. B. Prince, Esq. of Harrison Co.
 Pope deeded such of the said tract to the said Lewis and it is agreed by the parties hereto that
 the said sum of money shall not be paid under two or more years from the date hereof
 and that it shall be optional with said Lewis to pay the same within two years
 after the said last mentioned period provided he shall pay the interest annually from
 this date. It is further agreed that the said Prince shall pay the said sum of twenty
 five hundred dollars to the more existing judgment creditors of said Lewis as the
 same may be ascertained by reference to the judgment docket of the Clerk's Office of
 Southampton County and any other competent evidence. It is further agreed that should
 the amount due the existing judgment creditors of said Lewis exceed the sum of
 \$2500⁰⁰ then the said Prince is at liberty to annul this obligation. In the event
 of a sale by virtue hereof it shall be after 30 days public notice of time & place upon
 such terms as the said Prince may desire and in the said event the Trustee shall
 be entitled to the usual commission of 5% on gross sales. It is further agreed
 that the said Lewis shall keep up during the existence of this Deed all policy of
 Insurance for at least \$1000⁰⁰ on his dwelling house and his future sale he
 shall give the said Prince the right to foreclose this Trust
