Lewis for Eight hundred and Eighty Eight dollars and Seventy Five cents at six months from date, which said note is given with the understanding that it is privileged to be renewed in Bank for three months after its maturity and if so renewed, then the renewal is also covered and intended to be secured by this deed, And in the event of a sale by virtue hereof it shall be after ten days public notice of time & place and upon such terms as said Eastham Pocock & Co. or either of them may direct, And in such event the trustee shall be entitled to a commission of five percent on gross sales, Witness the foregoing signatures & seals.
