This Deed made this 15th day of April 1881, between S Lewis of the one part and W W Briggs Trustee of the other part, both of Southampton Co V^g. Witness that in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars in hand paid the said Lewis doth grant and convey unto the said Briggs Trustee as aforesaid, with general warranty the following property to wit: 5 mules & horses, 7 cattle, 23 hogs all household & kitchen furniture, wagon & carts 7 acres, all farming utensils, one buggy, one carriage cotton gin & fixtures, one still & fixtures Cider mill & fixtures, 75 barrels of corn 3000 lbs of Potatoes, 1000 lbs of Bacon a lot of sawed lumber at six cents at Kottoway Depot in Southampton County V^g a lot of lumber standing & felled bought of John Kindred and J. Fred Johnson, and all bonds & accounts as chosen in action now due & payable to said Lewis. In Trust, however to secure the payment of a bond for 160⁰⁰ due Elisha Lewis, dated January 27th 1881 and payable twelve months after date, at Exchange National Bank of Norfolk V^g and to secure from loss, the said Elisha Lewis, by reason of his having endorsed certain notes, Bonds, for the coming bonds on other obligations, due by said Lewis, to Whitehill Co for \$3500⁰⁰, as thus abate, to H R Griffin special Comr for about \$900⁰⁰, interest included to John Brown Adam Bailey, Brown \$300⁰⁰, as thus abate.

Witness that in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars in hand paid, the said Lewis doth grant and convey unto the said Briggs Trustee as aforesaid, with general warranty the following property to wit: His entire stock of goods, wares and merchandize, now in his store at his place of business, known as Farmers Store Southampton County V^g consisting of Dry goods, groceries, Hardware, Boots, shoes, hardware, crockery and House furniture & fixtures &c, & also what may in case of a sale of his Chattle property under a Deed of Trust of equal date with this Deed to W W Briggs Trustee for the benefit of Elisha Lewis, be left from said sale. In Trust, to secure the payment of the foregoing amount for \$300⁰⁰, due W F Brades dated April 15th 1881 and payable April 16th 1882, and a note due W F Brades for \$500⁰⁰, dated April 15th 1881, payable twelve months after date at National Bank of Norfolk V^g and also to secure the said W F Brades any loss which may sustain by reason of his having endorsed cer-
