tion of the sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) the receipt of which sum is hereby
acknowledged, the said Fannie E. Rose do grant and convey with general
power, unto the said John H. Dabb, all his right and interest in a certain
piece of Land situated in the County of Southampton and containing
122 1/2 acres, more or less (the same being her Documentary) and bounded by
the lands of Matthias Harris Williams, Drakes, Pierce Turner & others the same
being the farm formerly belonging to J. D. Rose & conveyed by Deed of Trust
from said Rose to J. D. Prince, Trustee for the benefit of S. Lewis dated 22nd
day of October 1877, of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County &
