Whereas, Charles Blunt, of Southampton County, Virginia, is engaged in the cultivation of the soil, during the year 1881, in and upon certain parcels of land lying in the County of Southampton, now in the occupancy of James R. West, and James R. West, of Southampton County, Virginia, has agreed to advance to the said Charles Blunt in money, as a supply, not to exceed in the whole the sum of one hundred dollars, which money is intended to be expended in the cultivation of the said parcels of land for which sum as advanced by the said James R. West, he is to be entitled to a lien, according to law, on the crops which may be made by the said Charles Blunt on the said parcels of land, during the year aforesaid. Now, this deed made between the said James R. West, of the one part, and the said Charles Blunt, of the other part, witnesses that it is agreed between the said parties that the said James R. West shall make advances of money as a supply to the said Charles Blunt in such sums and at such times as he may demand and require, the sum amount not exceeding in the whole the sum of one hundred dollars, which is intended to be expended in the cultivation of the parcels of land aforesaid, and which the said Charles Blunt, for himself and his heirs assigns, to the said James R. West or his assigns, on or before the 1st day of December 1881 with lawful interest on the several advances aforesaid from the time when they were respectively made, until payment, and it is further agreed by and between the said parties, that the said James R. West shall be entitled to a lien according to the statute in that case made and provided to the extent of the advances which he shall make on aforesaid to the said Charles Blunt, on all the crops which may be made by the said Charles Blunt on the parcels of land, during the year aforesaid.
